AMPLIFYING YOUTH PARTICIPATION

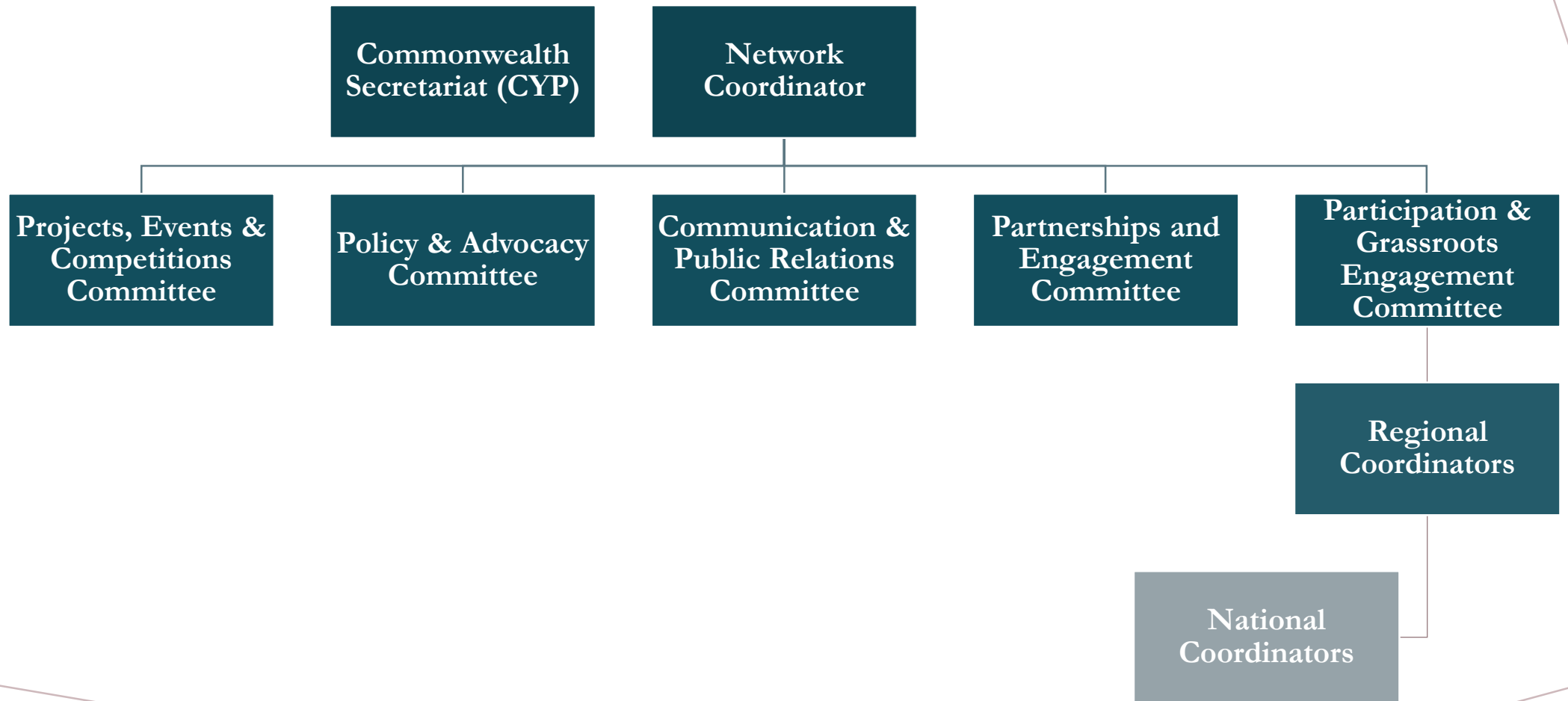
